- It doesn't include a list of questions to go through on every case
- The handbook provides basic understanding of
 - trafficking as a continuum
 - means of psychological control and coercion in the context of trafficking
 - why trafficked children don't always want to disclose and how it could be addressed
- The handbook includes an amendment to the NICHD-R interview protocol with examples

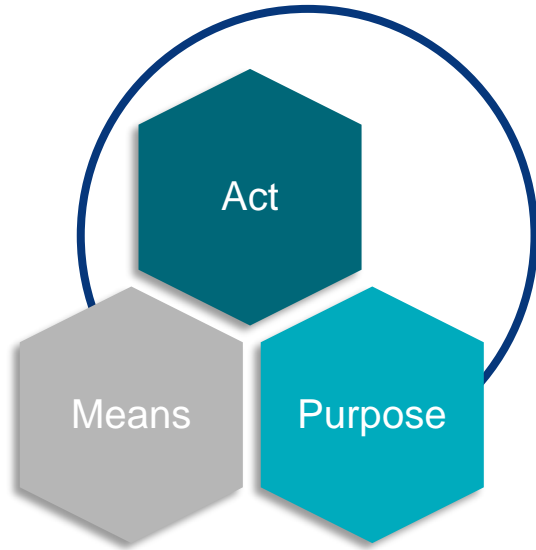

What is trafficking and why do we need a special approach with it?



- Nature of trafficking as a continuum over an extended period of time
- Victim's
 - "proactive" behaviour
 - self-reproach
 - criminal acts
- Ongoing continuity of the trafficking process
- **Perspective of the process is critical**

Preparing for an interview

- Getting the team together
- Taking the time to ensure the child's safety and create rapport
- Including the interpreter in the interview process
